

# **2018 GRAFTON JUNIOR TIM SCHAEFFER MEMORIAL GOLF CLASSIC**

1. Juniors must be registered, affiliated with bonafide members of the A.G.U. and have current club handicaps.
2. Players shall not win more than one trophy with the exception of the Clarence Valley Council Trophy for the best net score by a Grafton junior and N.T.P.'s.
3. The "Rules of Golf" and local rules of the day apply to all players.
4. *IF PLAYERS DO NOT ADHERE TO DRESS REGULATIONS THEY WILL BE REFUSED PLAY.* All other disputes will be decided by the Match Committee of the day, with no correspondence entered into.
5. All ties will be decided by countback except for the title of Junior Classic winner which will be decided by a stroke playoff over the first, eighth and ninth holes. If scores are stillTrophy for the sudden death over the same holes.
6. All players must report to the starter 15 minutes before their starting time, and be ready for play, or risk losing their place in the draw or disqualification.
7. The Committee reserves the right to change any division if nominations warrant.
8. *ALTHOUGH CADDIES ARE ALLOWED, PARENTS/CADDIES AND OTHERS ARE INSTRUCTED TO RESPECT THE RIGHTS OF JUNIORS TO MAKE THEIR OWN DECISIONS ON THE COURSE. ANY UNDUE INTERFERENCE BY CADDIES/OTHERS MAY RESULT IN THE DISQUALIFICATION OF THE PLAYER.*
9. Players must report to the scorer immediately after completing their round. Players are responsible for placing their handicap and signature on their card.
10. *ALCOHOL IS NOT ALLOWED ON THE GOLF COURSE. PLAYERS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED IF THEY OR THEIR CADDIES, PARENTS OR SPECTATORS IN THAT GROUP CONSUME ALCOHOL ON THE COURSE.*

## **REGISTRATION**

1. Players report to the professional to pay competition fees and collect lunch/drink ticket.
2. Take ticket to table outside pro shop where name, age, club and handicap is checked prior to receiving score card and attaching ticket to card.
3. Players will be called to their tee where the starter will bring players together and confirm local rules and special playing conditions, e.g. short course for cadets.

## **PRESENTATIONS**

1. Cadet presentation will take place early (approximately lunch time).
2. Senior presentation will take place as soon as possible after all scores have been recorded and tallied.
